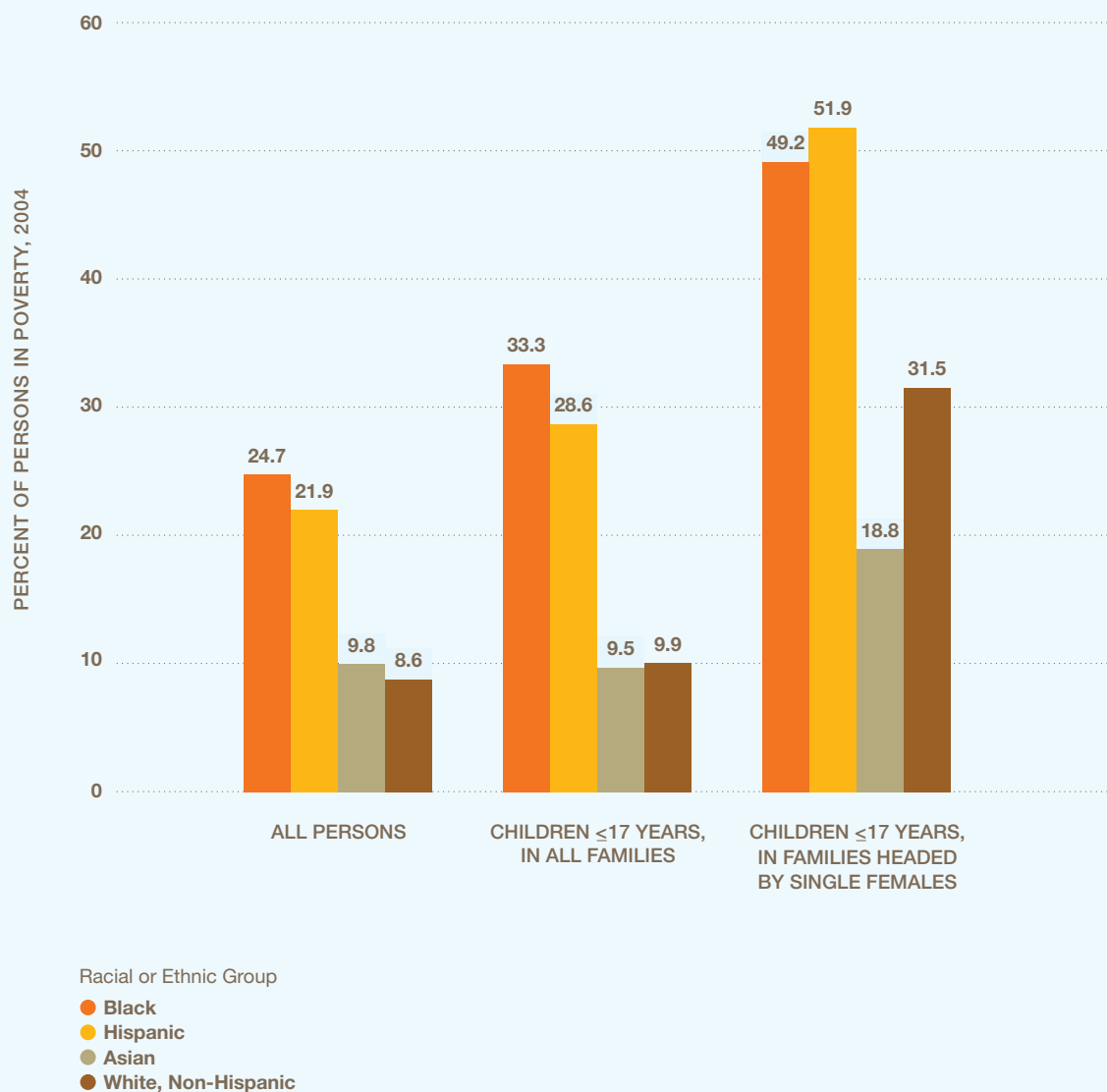


Racial or Ethnic Differences in Poverty
